

Board Minutes Monday March 6, 2017

The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am on March 6, 2017 with all members present.

Lee Bjerke, county Engineer, met with the Board to discuss road matters.

Moved by Ashbacher and seconded by Kuhn to adopt resolution 17-43, a correction to the Dry Creek Road vacation resolution 17-41 adopted February 27, 2017. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. The complete resolution will be on file in the county Auditor's and Recorder's offices.

Sean Snyder, Emergency Management Coordinator, met with the Board to give several EM updates.

Moved by Kuhn and seconded by Ashbacher to approve the DNR Environmental Review of the FEMA Home Buy-out properties. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Kuhn and seconded by Beard to certify the Debris Management Plan to be included with the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Beard and seconded by Ashbacher to authorize the asbestos testing for the properties included in the FEMA Home Buy-out program. Motion carried unanimously.

Kuhn was absent for the remainder of the meeting.

Steve Smith, IT Director, met with the Board to give IT updates.

Moved by Thompson and seconded by Beard to approve the hire of Fatimetu Barhir Jatri Emhamed as an IT intern and then to the position of IT Help Desk Specialist, after Immigration approval of her work Visa. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board reviewed the request to waive the separation distance requirement for a confinement building from the road right-of-way by Rodney Lensing. Moved by Thompson and seconded by Ashbacher to approve the waiver as requested per Iowa Code section 459.205. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Beard and seconded by Ashbacher to open the public hearing on the proposed Animal Confinement building by Stateline Hogs. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. The Board

received several comments both for and against the building. People wishing to make comments to the DNR can submit them in writing to the county Sanitarian by March 13th, and he will forward them to the DNR. The Board will vote on their recommendation to the DNR at the March 13th meeting. Moved by Thompson and seconded by Ashbacher to close the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Andy Van der Maaten, county Attorney, met with the Board to discuss county issues.

Moved by Ashbacher and seconded by Thompson to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the last meeting, the class C with Sunday sales liquor license for Nob Hill Supper Club, and to accept and file the monthly report of the county Recorder. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Thompson and seconded by Beard to appoint Jay Elsbernd to the open three year term on the Board of Health. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Thompson and seconded by Ashbacher to adjourn to 9:30am Monday March 13, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.
