



Board Minutes Friday February 26, 2010

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment with supervisors Logsdon, Darling, Ibanez, and Bouska present.

The Board met with Lee Bjerke, county Engineer, to discuss road matters.

Moved by Logsdon and seconded by Darling to keep the road crew workers on the standard eight hour days, five days per week, this year. According to the union contract the Board must decide to allow the four, ten hour days requested; or the five, eight hour days before March 1st. Supervisors Askelson joined the meeting via speaker phone. Motion carried with Logsdon, Askelson, and Darling voting aye; and Ibanez and Bouska voting nay.

Moved by Ibanez and seconded by Logsdon to approve the minutes for Monday February 22, 2010. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Logsdon and seconded by Bouska to approve the liquor license applications as follows: Class B with outdoor and Sunday sales for Our Lady of Seven Dolours Church; and Class C with Sunday sales for Nob Hill Inc. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Bouska and seconded by Logsdon to accept and file the January report of the Veterans Affairs Commission. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Bouska and seconded by Ibanez to adjourn to 9:30am Monday March 1, 2010. Motion carried unanimously.
